1. PRELIMINARY

1.1 Purpose

Yorkshire Cricket is committed to respecting and protecting your privacy. The Participant Privacy Notice (the **notice**) explains how we may use Personal Data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, in connection to your participation in Yorkshire Cricket matches, schemes and programmes.

1.2 Objectives

This notice seeks to ensure you have the assurance and clarity that Yorkshire Cricket Processes your data lawfully, fairly and in a transparent manner.

1.3 Scope

Yorkshire Cricket manages and facilitates the operation of community, performance pathway and recreational cricket. In doing so, Yorkshire Cricket may need to process your personal data in order to facilitate matches, schemes, programmes and other events to ensure these are run in an organised manner and to ensure the safety and security of all participants who engage with Yorkshire Cricket.

These events may be run solely by Yorkshire Cricket, or in collaboration with the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB), Chance to Shine, The Lord's Taverners and other such recognised bodies. Events could take place through the Performance Pathways, community and youth initiatives through the Yorkshire Cricket Foundation or recreational cricket through your local club through the cricket season.

As such, this notice applies to umpires, coaches, groundsman, scorers, players, administrators at local cricket clubs, participants, including volunteers, children and their families, who may participate in our matches, schemes and programmes.

We have a separate privacy notice that applies to customers who purchase tickets, merchandise or other goods or services from Yorkshire Cricket. You can view that privacy notice here https://yorkshireccc.com/club/club-information/privacy-policy/. Where this privacy notice refers to 'players' that is a reference to recreational players. We maintain a separate privacy notice for professional players and other Yorkshire Cricket employees, workers, players, contractors, volunteers, non-executive directors, trustees that is provided directly to those individuals.

For the purposes of data protection, the Controller relevant to this notice could be either Yorkshire County Cricket Club, Yorkshire Cricket Foundation or Yorkshire Cricket Board (together, **Yorkshire Cricket**) depending on the processing activity for which we are Processing your Personal Data. This notice does not form part of any contract to provide services or otherwise between you and Yorkshire Cricket.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

3. WHAT INFORMATION DOES YORKSHIRE CRICKET COLLECT?

You provide us with Personal Data when you participate in Yorkshire Cricket programmes. In addition, when you use our website, certain Personal Data may be collected automatically.

When you or someone in your care is participating in matches, schemes or programmes being operated by us, we may need to obtain more sensitive Personal Data – known as Special Categories of Personal Data - such as health or medical data about such individuals to ensure we can assist, where needed, in a medical emergency. Such medical information is treated with a higher level of security in our organisation and will only be requested where it is necessary to protect the health and safety of individuals under our supervision.

4. WHERE WE COLLECT YOUR INFORMATION

We typically collect Personal Data about participants through your choice to register yourself or a family member to take part in any of our matches, schemes or programmes, by either registering in person or online. As referenced above, we may also collect certain technical information through your use of our website.

We may sometimes collect additional information from third party sources such as the ECB (https://www.ecb.co.uk/). ECB in their role as the national governing body for cricket may share information with us in relation to umpires, coaches and other individuals who are needed to facilitate matches, schemes and programmes we operate, or where these individuals participate in coaching courses we run in partnership with the ECB. This information is used by us in order to ensure that we can organise sporting, youth and community events in our role as the governing body for cricket in Yorkshire.

The ECB may also share data with us in relation to individuals who participate in All Stars and Dynamos programmes so that Yorkshire Cricket is able to assist with the facilitation of these programmes at a local level.

Yorkshire Cricket may also collect data from the ECB's Play Cricket platform if you have chosen to register and upload your data to that platform. The Play Cricket privacy notice is available at: https://www.play-cricket.com/privacy

Personal Data will be stored in a range of different places, including in our participant databases and in other IT systems, including the email system where your customer support query may need specific attention from one of our staff.

5. WHY DOES YORKSHIRE CRICKET PROCESS PERSONAL DATA?

The table below describes the main purposes for which we Process your Personal Data, the categories of your information involved and our lawful basis for being able to do this.

6. WHO HAS ACCESS TO DATA?

We may share your Personal Data with the following parties:

- we may need to share your personal information between members within the Yorkshire Cricket group (i.e. Yorkshire County Cricket Club, Yorkshire Cricket Foundation and Yorkshire Cricket Board) where this is necessary for the purposes set out in this notice;
- internally within Yorkshire Cricket for the purpose of providing a service to you, including safeguarding officers and external case management system providers if access to the Personal Data is necessary for the performance of their roles;
- other cricket associations and bodies (e.g. ECB, Chance to Shine, The Lord's Taverners and other such recognised bodies) so that we may facilitate the provision of cricket matches, schemes and programmes, where this is processing is necessary as part of the organisation and administration of these events;
- analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our website; and
- if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce any legal agreement we have with you; or to protect our rights or property, or the safety of us, our customers, or others.
 This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction as well as addressing any safeguarding concerns.

6.1 Transferring Your Data Internationally

The Personal Data we collect may be transferred to and stored in countries outside of the UK and the European Union. Some of these jurisdictions require different levels of protection in respect of Personal Data and, in certain instances, the laws in those countries may be less protective than the jurisdiction you are typically resident in. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your Personal Data is only used in accordance with this Privacy Notice and applicable data protection laws and is respected and kept secure. We will only transfer such personal data to third parties where we have carried out due diligence on such third parties to ensure they will protect your personal data and only where we have appropriate safeguards in place, as required under UK GDPR. You have a right to request a copy of these safeguards.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL technology. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share a password with anyone.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, and we will maintain appropriate technical and organisation measures to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our website; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

7. HOW LONG WE KEEP PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it which will include satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Any personal data that we process will be deleted from our systems once we have completed the purpose for which we were processing the personal data. In some cases, the purpose for which we are processing your personal data will last for a considerable period (for example, if you are a long term customer of ours, we will need to store your data until our relationship with you comes to an end).

To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements. We will take into consideration a number of factors such as your relationship with us, your engagement with us, and the fulfilment of contracts we have with you.

We may need to retain your personal data where this is necessary to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations, or to protect the vital interest or the vital interests of another natural person.

8. YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO PERSONAL DATA

You have the following rights in relation to your Personal Data:

- Access and obtain a copy of your Personal Data on request;
- Require Yorkshire Cricket to change incorrect or incomplete Personal Data;
- Require Yorkshire Cricket to delete or stop of Processing your Personal Data, for example
 where the Personal Data is no longer necessary for the purposes of Processing;
- Object to the Processing of your Personal Data where Yorkshire Cricket is relying on its legitimate interests as the legal ground for Processing;
- Require Yorkshire Cricket to restrict Processing of your Personal Data, where certain requirements are met;
- Require Yorkshire Cricket to delete your Personal Data, where certain requirements are met;
- Request Yorkshire Cricket to transfer elements of your Personal Data either to you or another service provider ('right to data portability'), where certain conditions apply.

If you believe we have not complied with your data protection rights, you can complain to the Information Commissioner by writing to Information Commissioner's Office, Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire SK9 5AF, or online at www.ico.org.uk.

However, we are here to help and encourage you to contact us to resolve your complaint first.

9. WHAT IF YOU DO NOT PROVIDE PERSONAL DATA?

Where we process your data because it is necessary to fulfil a contract that we are entering into with you, the consequence of not providing the Personal Data required is that we will not be able to conclude the relevant contract.

10. AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING

Yorkshire Cricket will not make decisions about you based solely on automated decision-making in connection with the purposes set out this Privacy Notice.

11. CHANGES TO THIS NOTICE

We may update this Privacy Notice from time to time. When we change this notice in a material way, we will update the version date at the bottom of this page.
