

The People and Culture team take a people first approach to providing advice, support and knowledge for all staff across Yorkshire Cricket to develop a positive, cohesive and safe culture allowing everyone to perform to their full potential.

Job Purpose

Lead on the successful implementation of Yorkshire Cricket's safeguarding strategy across allocated areas of responsibility (including case management), to position Yorkshire Cricket as the industry leader in safeguarding and develop an effective safeguarding culture across Yorkshire Cricket, covering both the professional and recreational game.
