
PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- ✓ Be disciplined, punctual and reliable;
- ✓ Take responsibility for preparation, practice, fitness and equipment;
- ✓ Train hard, train smart and embrace feedback;
- ✓ Face challenges with courage and resilience;
- ✓ Treat every selection as an opportunity;
- √ Value effort, learning and growth as much as winning;
- ✓ Respect coaching decisions; and
- ✓ Set goals, stay ambitious and own your development.

- ✓ Put the team first: support and encourage others;
- ✓ Bring positive energy to training and matches;
- ✓ Respect coaches, officials, captains and staff;
- √ Keep areas tidy, respect equipment and report any damage;
- ✓ Communicate openly about availability, illness or injury;

- ✓ Be honest and report issues promptly; and
- ✓ Celebrating everyone's success on and off the field.

THINK BIG

- ✓ Play hard, play fair: respect umpires, opponents and the game;
- ✓ Be grateful to officials, coaches, teammates and staff;
- ✓ Be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat;
- ✓ Never engage in bullying, abuse or offensive behaviour online or offline;
- ✓ Follow all YCCC Pathway policies;
- \checkmark Respect the rights, dignity and worth of everyone involved; and
- $\checkmark\,$ Represent the game and club positively, on and off the field and at all times.
- ✓ Challenge yourself: extra practise, try new skills, and learn from mistakes;
- ✓ Show courage and resilience in training, matches and life;
- ✓ Balance cricket, school and personal life responsibly;
- ✓ Look after your health: rest, eat well and avoid harmful substances;
- ✓ Represent Yorkshire CCC with pride on and off the field; and
- ✓ Trust the programme to prepare you for the next level.

CONSEQUENCES FOR BREACHING THE CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Verbal Reminder: Coaches address minor breaches and reinforce Pathway values all reminders are recorded;
- 2. Written Warning: Repeated breaches are reported to families with clear expectations for improvement;
- 3. Temporary Suspension: Participation in training or matches may be restricted until behaviour improves;
- 4. Loss of Selection: You may miss fixtures, festivals, squads or events until standards are met; and
- 5. Exclusion: Serious or repeated breaches may result in an exit from the Pathway to protect the integrity, safety and culture of YCCC.

Consequences will be considered on a case-by-case basis, taking into account each player's individual circumstances and the context of the situation.
