- Stewarding and stadium plan- the MRG were run through plans about what stands/gates to open for different types of games at Headingley in order to save on stewarding costs. The group suggested a couple of tweaks that members would benefit from.
- Stadium WiFi- the club is assessing potential solutions prior to the Women's T20 World Cup.
